

Welcome to the Board of Police Commissioners Public Meeting

1. Please **sign-in**.
2. In accordance with the City Charter: Each Member of the public who has signed-in will have up to a total of **three minutes** to address the Board.
3. The Chairperson of the Board, or the Vice Chairperson in the Chair's absence, shall **conduct the meeting** in an orderly manner. Members of the Board and all others in attendance shall obey the directions of the Chairperson conducting the meeting.
4. **Public speaking** at this meeting is to provide citizens the opportunity to be heard, express their views, and inform the Board of Police Commissioners and the Lansing Police Department Administration.
5. In accordance with the **City of Lansing Charter**, in no case is this an opportunity for a citizen to speak in the nature of a debate and neither the Police Board nor the Administration is under any obligation to respond specifically to any speaker.
6. **All remarks** shall be addressed to the Police Board, the Chief, and/or Lansing Police Department representatives **through the Chairperson** conducting the meeting.
7. Individual Commissioners, the Chief, or representatives of the Lansing Police Department present shall address the **Chairperson** for permission to inquire of speakers or members of the audience whenever he or she deems that such an inquiry may be **helpful** to Lansing Police Department business.
8. No speaker called upon to speak shall - by speech or conduct - disturb, disrupt, delay, interfere with, or otherwise impede the **orderly conduct** of the meeting. Speakers shall adhere to the time limits established by these Rules and the Chairperson.
9. **Extension** of a speaker's time limit is permissible at the **discretion** of the Chairperson; or on a motion of a Commissioner, by affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Commissioners present.
10. No person in attendance shall engage in speech or conduct which disturbs, disrupts, delays, interferes with or otherwise impedes the orderly conduct of the meeting. The Chairperson may rule any member of the public who is a speaker or meeting attendee, **out of order** for failing to follow Board of Police Commissioners Rules or the Chairperson's directions, and may take appropriate action when necessary to restore order to the meeting, including the exclusion of a person who breaches the peace during the meeting.
