

Lansing City Marijuana Updates- November 1, 2019

Nov. 18 – Accepting applications for ONLY certain types

As we implement the new Marijuana [Ordinance](#), the Clerk's Office will be opening 30 days windows for certain marijuana operations. Applications will be accepted online starting on Monday, November 18 for **only** the following types:

- Medical Transport
- Adult Use Transport
- Medical Safety Compliance
- Adult Use Safety Compliance
- Medical Processor
- Adult Use Processor

Instructions will be available soon for the online submission and payment process, which will be very similar format and process we have been using in 2019.

The application window of time for unlimited license types will be open more than license types that have a limit. As soon as we set a time period for accepting applications for capped operations, we will be sending out a communication.

Attestation C-2 and I-F Forms

Please do not bring **Attestation C-2, I-F forms** to any City departments. The Clerk's Office will complete the form, sign and notarize it upon conditional approval of your submitted City application.

Applicants will be notified when approved, and a time will be arranged to pick up a notarized attestation from the South Washington Office Complex, which is located at 2500 S. Washington, in the back of the building.
